Add your thank you prayer to the blessings umbrella!



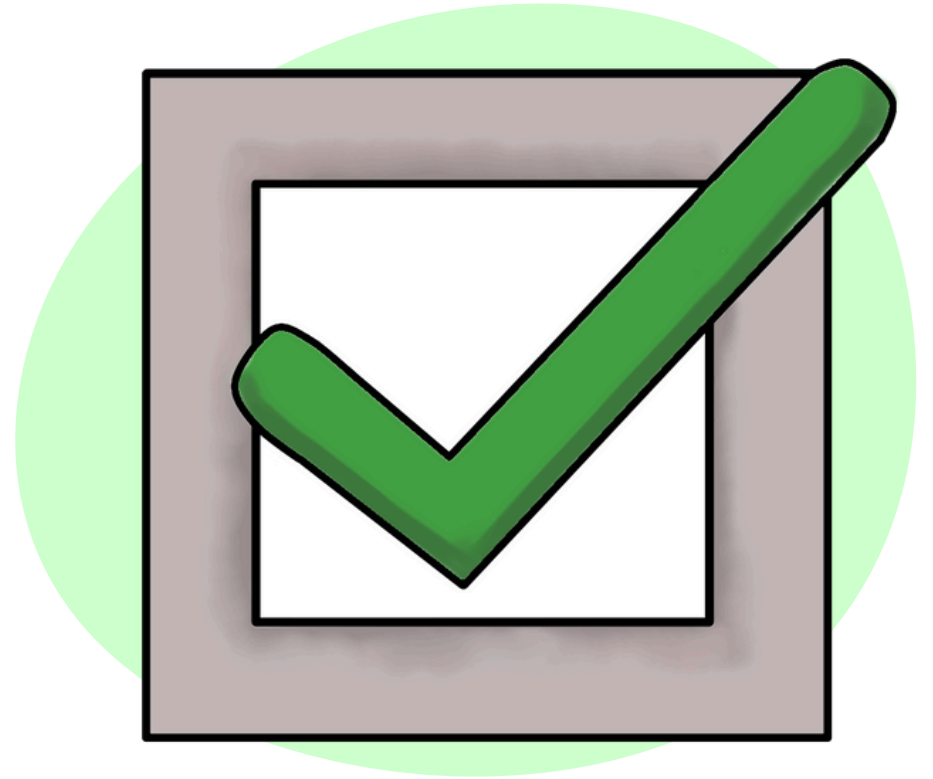
## 2 Corinthians 9 v 8

Write your name on a card and place it in the basket, then pick out somebody else's name and pray for them!



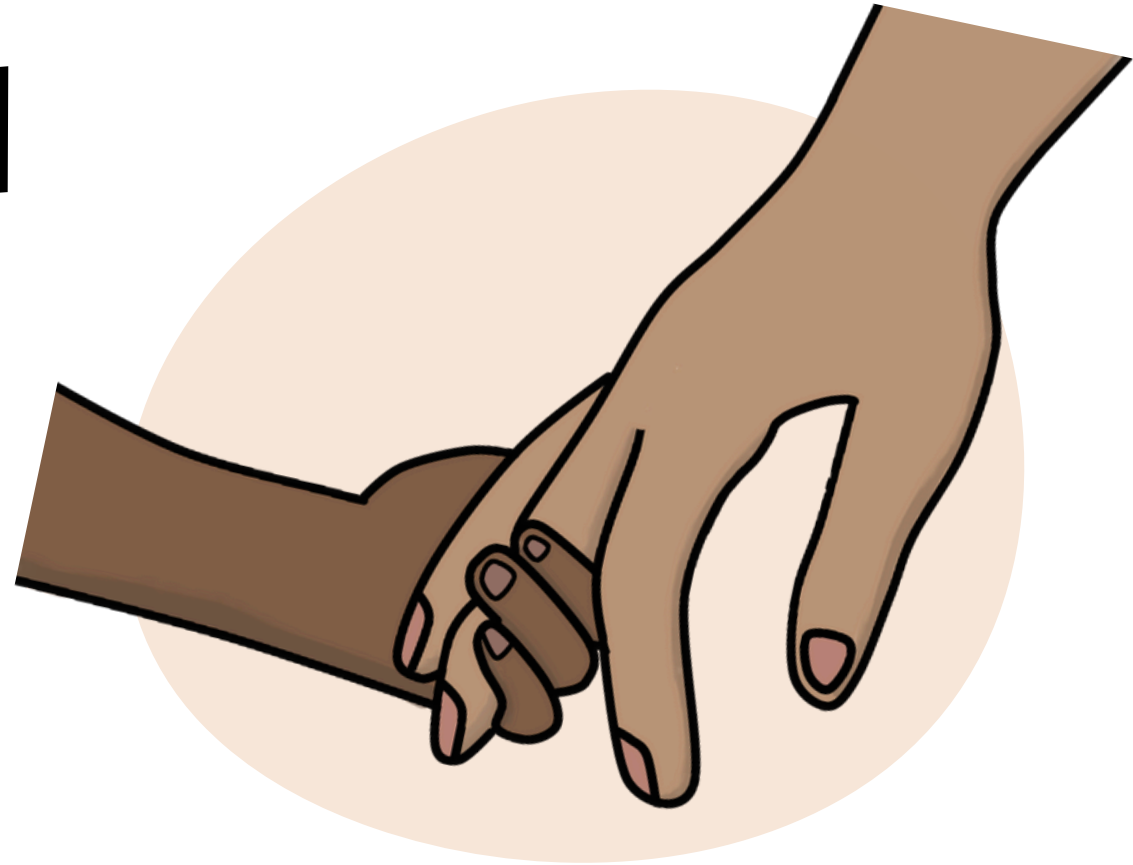
## Ephesians 1 v 4

## John 1 v 12

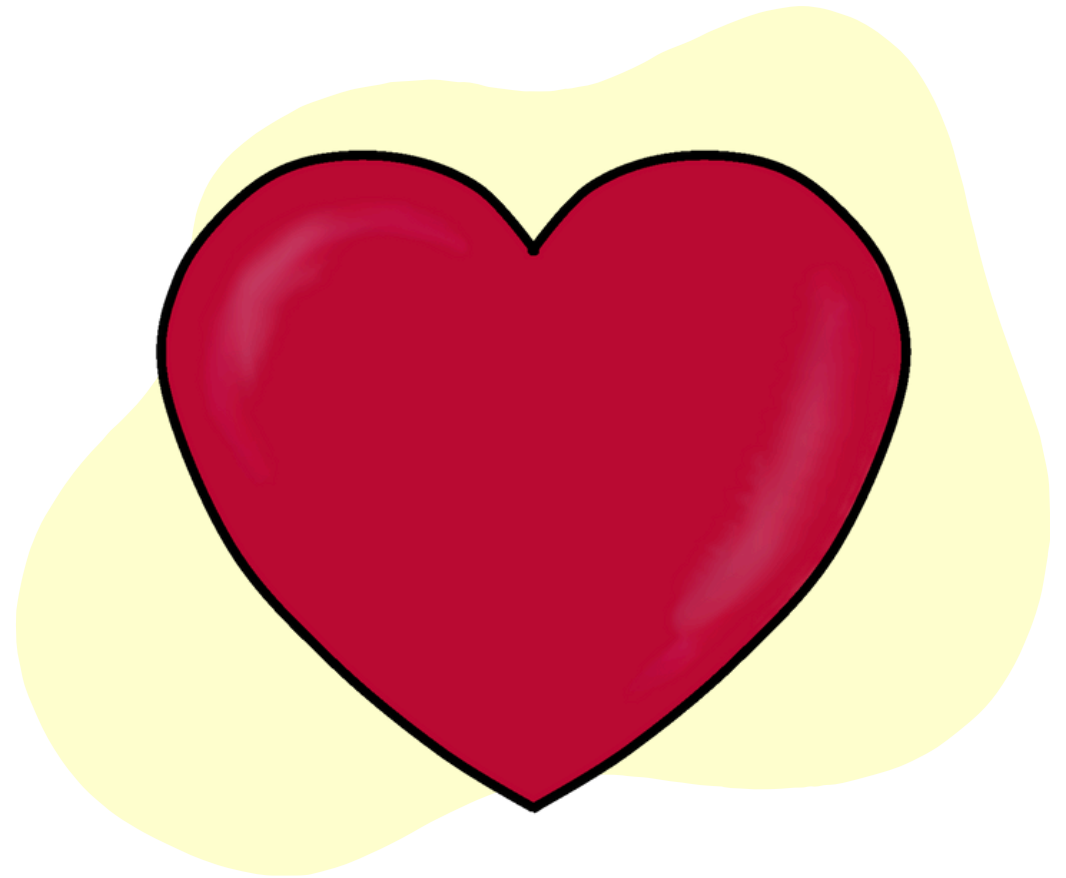
"But to all who did accept him and believe in him he gave the right to become children of God."

loves about who you are!



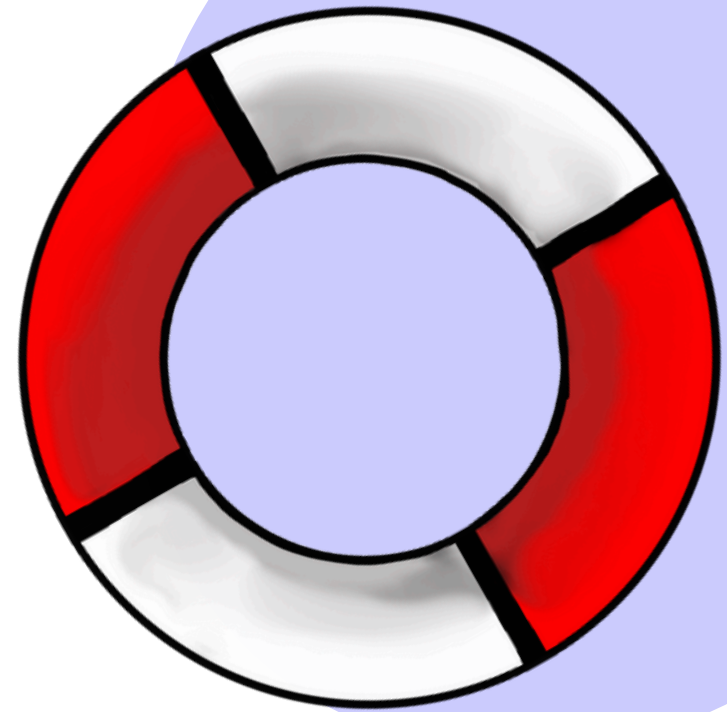
## Jeremiah 31 v 3

# Victorious

God promises us victory! We can know success because God is on our team.

Chat to God about an area where you want help to feel like a victorious winner! finish your prayer with a big “amen”, shooting a ball into the goal!

Remember that even if it doesn't go in, God still hears our prayers!



## 1 Corinthians 15 v 57

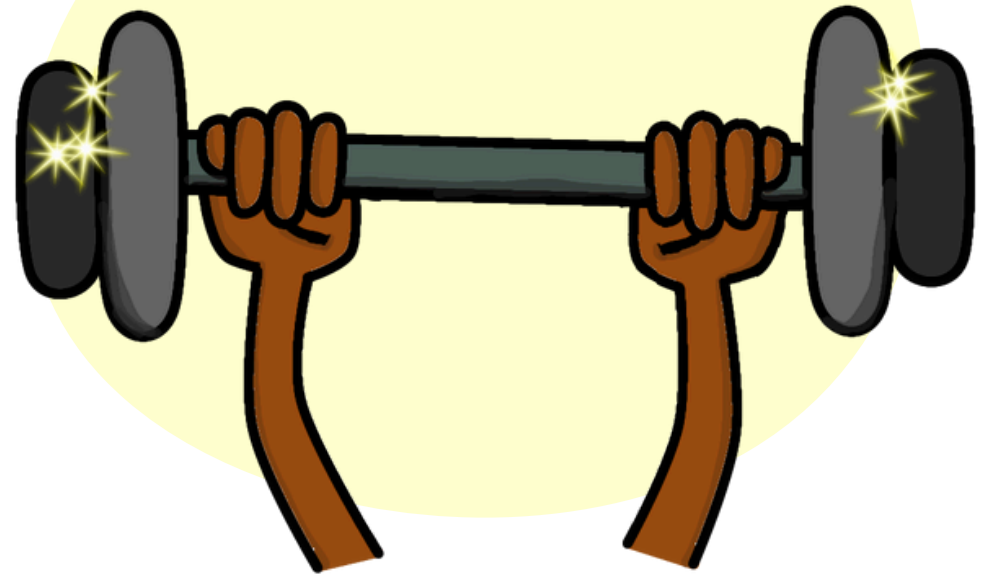
“But we thank God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.”



# Strong

God says we are strong, because he gives us his power! The Bible also tells us that having friends around us help us to be strong, like a rope made of three twisted strands.

## Ephesians 6 v 10

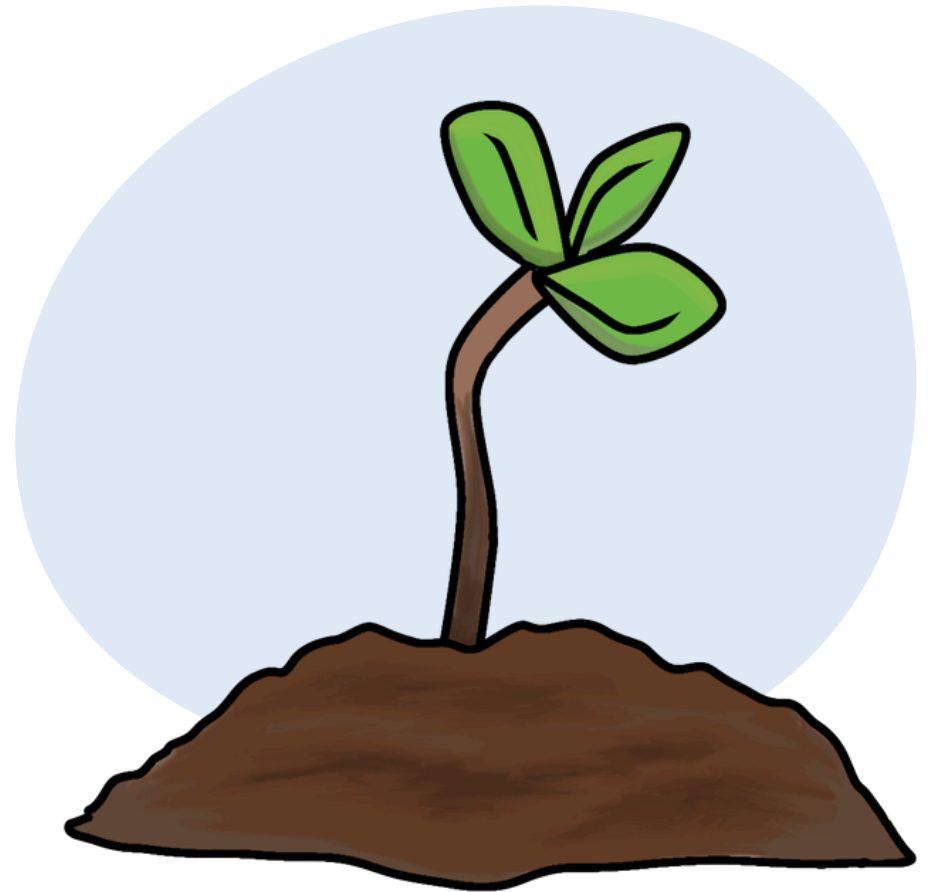
“...finally, be strong in the Lord and in his great power.”

# Rooted

A plant puts down roots to draw in goodness from the soil and help it grow strong and tall. We can hold on tight to God, rooted in him.

Using a pencil make a small hole in the soil for your seed. Drop the seed into the soil and cover it.

Ask God to help you grow stronger in your own faith, rooted in Him.



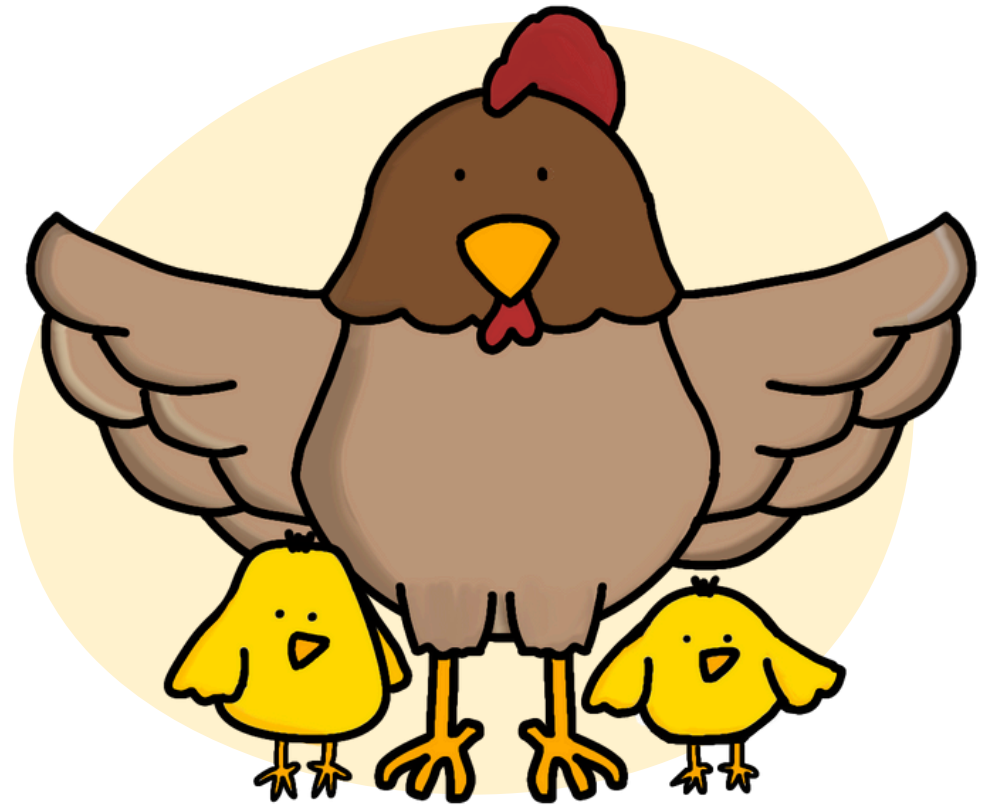
## Colossians 2 v 7

# Safe

Take some time to sit in the tent and ask God to surround you with his perfect peace. Chat to God and tell him about any fears or anxiety you might have.



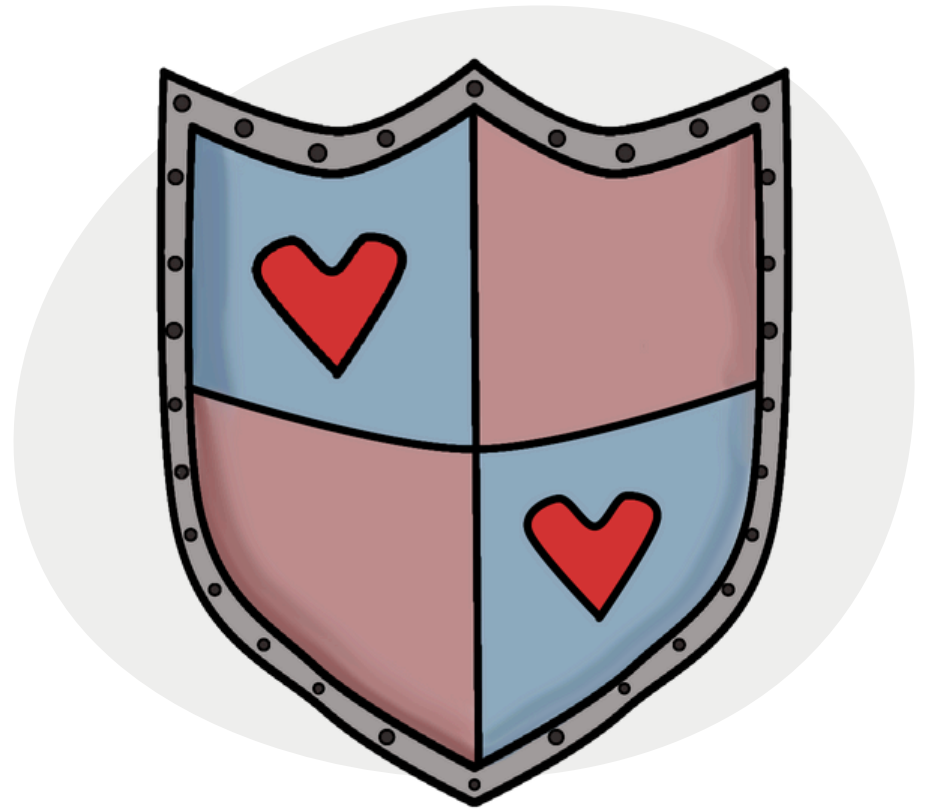
## Psalm 57 v 1

Hold onto one of the bubbles and chat to God about anything that is making you feel worried or anxious. Then pop the bubble asking God to be your protector and take your worry away!



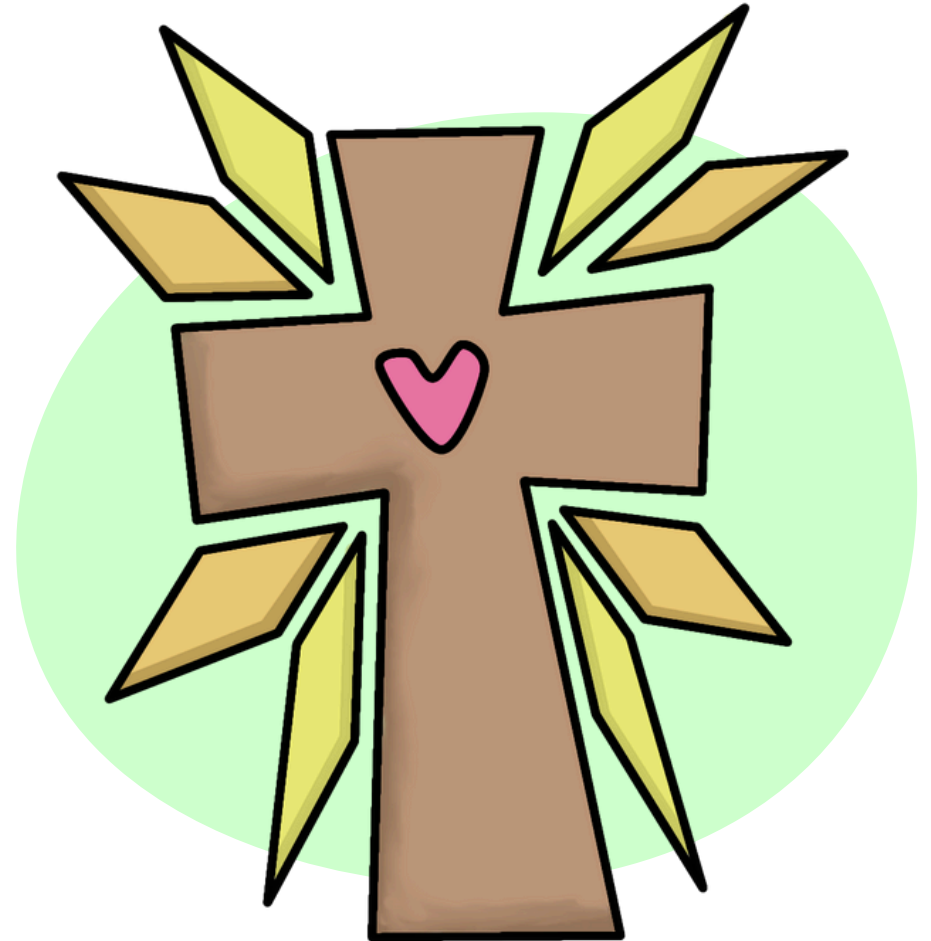
## Psalm 18 v 2

# Forgiven

Pause at the cross and say thank you to God that he forgives all our mistakes.

others for God?



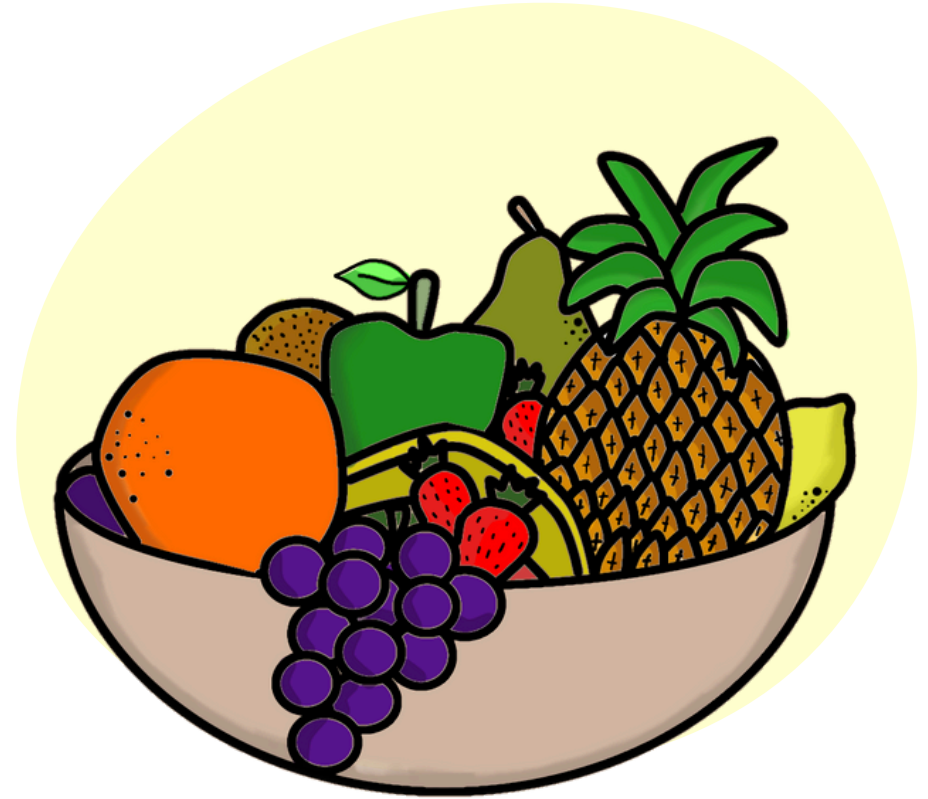
## 1 Corinthians 12 v 4

## Romans 8 v 37

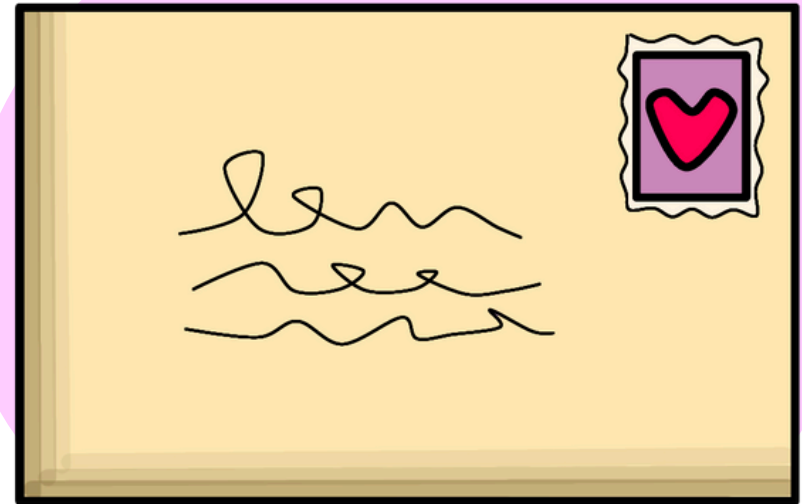
"But in all these things we are completely victorious

The Bible says that we can trust in God to be our guide helping us to make good decisions and know what to do.



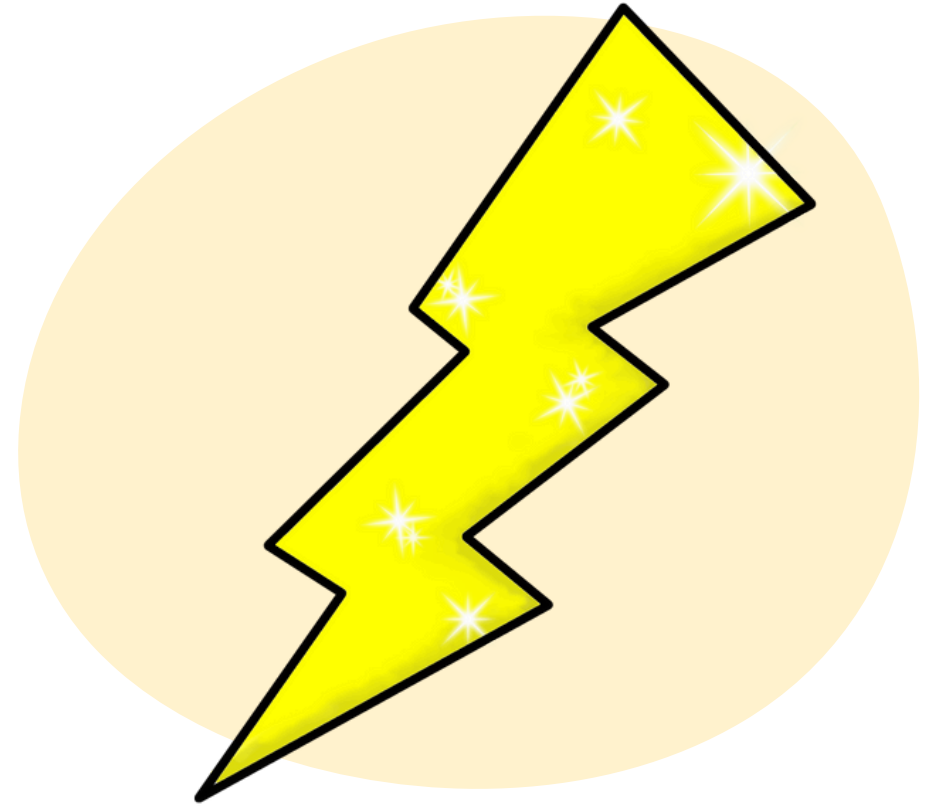
## Isaiah 58 v 11

We have the power to be world changers today as well! Spend some time praying for the world. Write or draw your prayer on a post-it note and add it to the map.



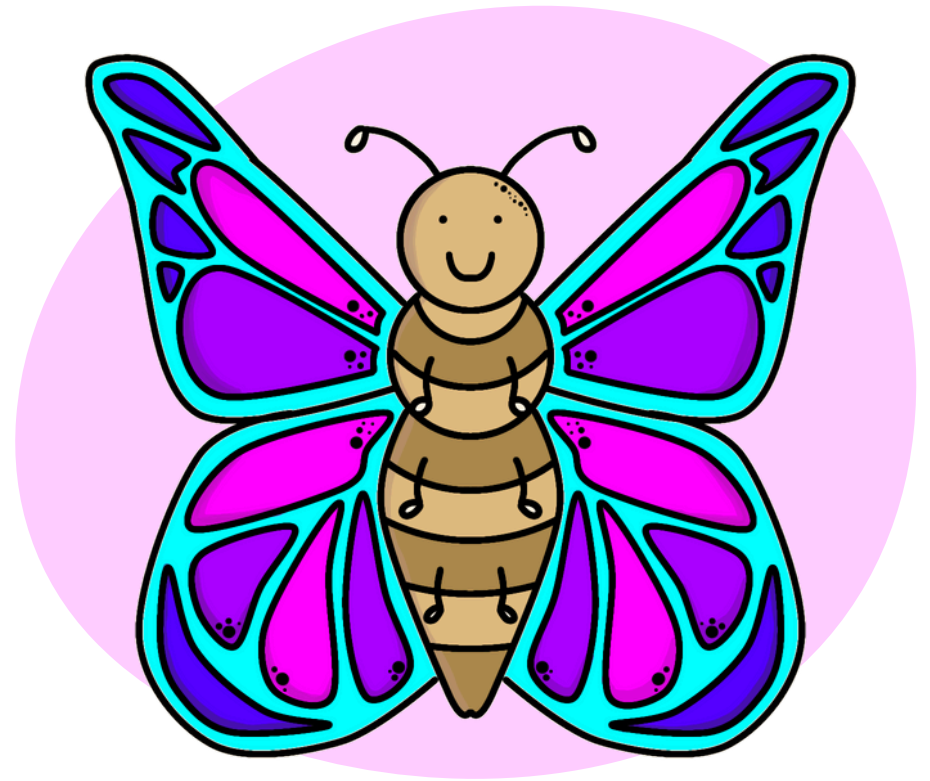
## Acts 1 v 8
